Deadline for mailed registration and 12th grade scholarship award application: Must be postmarked by May 6th, 2017.

Parents/Student: *Your registration/application must include the following* (applications will be rejected without ALL of the following):

- Registration fee of \$25 per student (except 12th graders applying for scholarship, see instructions below) -- check or money order only - NO CASH ACCEPTED. Please make the check payable to "**Academic Achievement Award**". The registration fee is spent to prepare trophy, certificate, and gift card.
- A self-addressed stamped envelope (for notification)
- A COMPLETED Registration Form

Qualifications:

1. Vietnamese or Vietnamese-American students: grades Kindergarten through 12th.
2. Current student of a public or private school within the area codes of (415), (628), or (650). *Students of Au Co Center are exempt from the area code requirement.*
3. Having demonstrated academic excellence (see **GPA & Report Card** guidelines below).

GPA & Report Card guidelines:

- ❖ **Kindergarten – 5th grade:** Submit photocopies of the two most current report periods. In the most current period, at least 80% of the total grade points must be "3", "4", "S", or "O".
For Fifth Graders ONLY: To be considered for the Outstanding Academics Award for Elementary School, please submit copies of the scores from the student's 3rd and 4th grade STAR or SBAC or equivalent tests and documentation of other awards.
- ❖ **6th – 12th grade** (Middle & High School): Submit photocopies of report cards for the Fall 2016 Semester and Spring 2017 (1st and 2nd grading periods). Overall GPA must be at least 3.50.
For Eighth Graders ONLY: To be considered for the Outstanding Academics Award for Middle School, please submit copies of the scores from the student's 6th and 7th grade STAR or SBAC or equivalent tests and documentation of other awards.

Please note: These guidelines are based on the San Francisco School District grading system. For students outside of the San Francisco School District, please submit copies of the report cards for the last two grading periods having the equivalent of a GPA of 3.5 or higher. If you don't know how to convert the grade points or if you're not sure about your student's qualifications, please send in the application packet and the Screening Committee will do the work for you. **If your student does not qualify for an award, your registration fee will be fully refunded.**

Scholarships for 12th grade students who have been accepted to a college for the 2017-2018 school year:

- ❖ Three scholarships of \$1,000 each for students with excellent academic results and/or from low and moderate-income families, minimum GPA of 3.5.
- ❖ One scholarship of \$1,500 for Outstanding Academics Award for High School, minimum GPA of 3.5.

Twelfth-grade students can also apply for the 12th grade scholarship, the student **must** fill out and submit **all** application requirements as listed in the scholarship application, which is different from the Academic Excellence Award registration form. More scholarship information and the application form can be downloaded from www.aucocenter.org, requested by e-mail from auco@aucocenter.org, or picked up at Au Co Center as mentioned above. **The 12th grade scholarship application is exempt from the \$25 registration fee. Any 12th grade student applying for the Outstanding Academic Award or Hardship Scholarship does not have to register for the Academic Excellence Award.** We will notify applicants 1-2 weeks after receipt of the application. Names of the scholarship recipients will be posted online approximately 10 days before the 2017 Academic Excellence Awards Ceremony at <http://www.aucocenter.org>.
